We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2016-17 educational progress for Lybrook Elementary. For the 2016-17 school year, schools were identified using new definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was not identified with any of these labels.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

 - a. Students are assigned to the Elementary School by grade level based on age.
 - b. We currently serve grades Preschool-5th grade.

 - a. Along with our regular education services provided through our middle school, we are pleased to be able to provide additional services through Berrien RESA. Berrien RESA provides services to special needs students through Blossomland Learning Center, Lighthouse Education Center, and the Berrien County Hearing Impaired Program. Furthermore, Berrien RESA works in conjunction with the Berrien County Juvenile Detention Center to provide services to students being housed at the center.
